James Scoby. Civil War Veteran. He enlisted on December 23, 1862 at the age of 21. On March 31, 1863, he enlisted in Company C, 1st SS Regiment. On June 16, 1863, he received a disability discharge from Company C at Detroit. He is buried in North Side Cemetery, Maybee.

John Banmiller. 1838-February 2, 1925. Civil War Veteran. He enlisted on November 18, 1862, in the First Michigan Light Artillery Battalion K. He is buried in St. Paul Cemetery, Maybee.

Corporal John Gavana. Co. D., 7th Michigan Infantry. He is buried in St. Joseph Cemetery, Maybee.

with 1 Star, American Area Campaign Medal, Victory
Medal. He is buried in St. Joseph Cemetery, Maybee.

Ralph A. Iott. Pfc. U.S. Army, World War II. He is
buried in St. Joseph Cemetery, Maybee.

Ervin A. Jaworski. U.S. Navy, World War II. Ervin served
his country in the U.S. Navy during WWII from March
25, 1941 to February 23, 1947. He served aboard the
aircraft carrier USS Yorktown when it was torpedoed by
the enemy during the Battle of Midway in June of 1942.
Disregarding the order to abandon ship, Ervin stayed
behind helping crewmates to safety. Among his awards,
he earned the American Defense Service medal with 1
Star, the Asiatic Pacific Theater Ribbon with 7 Stars, the
American Area Ribbon, Philippine Liberation Ribbon
with 2 Stars, and the Good Conduct and Victory Medals.
He is buried in St. Joseph Cemetery, Maybee.

William Kiebler, Jr. Sgt. U.S. Army, World War II. He is buried in St. Joseph Cemetery, Maybee.

Arlington W. Lentz. Pvt. U.S. Army. World War II. Purple Heart. He is buried in North Side Cemetery, Maybee.
